Determine theme and points to emphasize with reference to application to young Christians. 3. Decide on craft , game or activity sheets to embellish theme. 4. Gather: Children’s Chapel Bin, Attendance Folder, Activity Sheets, Storybook, Snack 5. Check Supply Closet for supplies you may need. 6. Take chairs down and lay protective table cloths as needed. 						
<p>Scriptural Reference</p> <p>Philippians 2: 5-11</p>	<p>Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus,</p> <p>who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited, but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death— even death on a cross.</p> <p>Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.</p>

<p>Story Path & Discussion <u>The Day I became a Bird</u> By Ingrid Chabbert</p>	<p>In <i>The Day I Became a Bird</i>, a boy loves his classmate, Sylvia, but she only ever notices birds. The boy so deeply wants to be seen and known by Sylvia that he dresses as a bird to get her attention. In Philippians it tells us that Jesus, though he was in the form of God, chose, instead, to humble himself and take the form of a human. Jesus loved us so much that he chose to become like us, so that we would see him and know him. Jesus shows us that love is worth reaching out and doing extraordinary things to show how we feel.</p>						

<p>Application Activity & Snack Big/Little Buddies Children’s Worship Bulletin Craft Game Play Time Playground</p>	<p>Discuss the difference between humility and pride. Give examples as needed. Have kids give examples. Play game – give kids a scenario. First they react with pride, next they react with humility.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Receive A on test 2. Kick winning goal at soccer 3. Teacher declares you are the best singer in the class 4. Give a birthday gift to a friend at his party <p>Ask how can you show humility or humbleness at today’s picnic? Give time to discuss with person sitting next to them then each child reports what they plan to do. Ideas: pick up trash, clear someone else’s plate and garbage, let older people go first, be good sports in games.</p>
