Directions to Chinook Farms

Directions from Seattle & Bellevue:

- Interstate 405 north
- Take Exit 23 to Eastbound Hwy 522
- Take Fales Road/Echo Lake Road Exit
- Go left under overpass onto Fales Road
- Continue for two miles to stop sign.
- Left at stop sign onto Elliott Road
- Chinook Farms is ahead on your right.

Directions from North

- Take Highway 9 South toward Clearview.
- Take left at light at 164th Street SE.
- Proceed one mile to stop sign.
- Turn right and immediate left onto Elliott Road.
- Cross railroad tracks and proceed one mile down windy hill.
- Chinook Farms is on your left.
